Your child can practice writing their numbers with the poems.

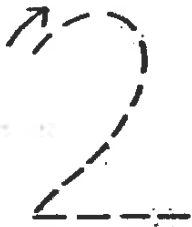
Around we go to make a zero.



Straight down, one is fun!



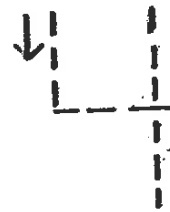
Around and back on a railroad track, two, two, two.



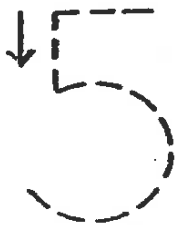
Around a tree and around a tree, that is how you make a three.
