<b>Functions</b>	<p>In addition to the usual Primary Teacher duties, Kindergarten and K/1 teachers apply knowledge of the following in planning classroom program:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Kindergarten Program using goals and learning outcomes in all areas as outlined in Full Day Kindergarten Program Guide 2010 and the Primary Program Document</li> <li>• Knowledge of Ministry of Education Early Learning Framework understanding of "K" assessment including the Kindergarten Early Learning Continuum and the Early Success Screening</li> <li>• Knowledge of child development and how young children learn understanding of social, emotional, intellectual, physical and aesthetic development of young children</li> <li>• Understand and embrace principles of learning through play thorough understanding of play based learning and knowing how to implement types of structured play into full day program</li> <li>• Disposition to work with young children and their families in a warm, caring, supporting environment committed to encouraging parent involvement in full day program</li> <li>• Provide an enriched environment where all children have opportunities to be full participants in their learning</li> <li>• Work collaborative as part of an Early Learning School Team including Principal, EA, teachers, Speech and Language Pathologists, and others</li> <li>• Knowledge of aboriginal education, language and culture</li> </ul>

	<b>Education and Training 3 Credits = 1.5 units</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A Bachelor's Degree in Education</li> <li>• Teaching degree with Early Learning/Early Years specialty</li> <li>• If new to K: Minimum 1/ ½ units of university credit in Early Years/Full Day Kindergarten before starting teaching Kindergarten Total of 4.5 units or 9 credits of Early Learning Full Day Kindergarten specialty by September 2013 plus committed to participation in ongoing inservice</li> </ul>
	<b>Additional Requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Successful experience as a Kindergarten teacher</li> <li>• Participate in ongoing in-service focused on a Full Day Kindergarten Program</li> </ul>

Where a fully qualified Teacher is not available for appointment, preference will be given to candidate with partial qualification plus a written commitment to complete the requirements within an agreed upon length of time.
