

Site-Specific Safety Plan Details

Site name: GEORGE BONNER ELEMENTARY

1. Occupancy limits for any shared or common work areas:

Occupancy limits posted on doors of all common areas like bookroom, copy rooms and staffroom

2. Directions for Student Pick-up, Drop-off and entry to reduce gathering and congregation:

Morning drop off and afternoon pickup times are staggered by 5 minutes 8:25-2:13 for odd numbered cohorts 8:30-2:18 for even numbered cohorts

Each cohort has been assigned a specific entry/exit door-5 total

Lunch hour is staggered Odd # cohorts 11:00-11:43, Even # cohorts 11:48 to 12:33

Parents have been told to wear masks while on the school grounds unless they can maintain at least 6 feet from others. Parents also asked to drop off and pick up in a timely manner and not to linger on the school grounds.

3. Indoor areas that lack capacity for distancing and that include interaction of staff with multiple cohorts:

Office Area Table and counter provided as buffer in office area. Teachers must call ahead before sending students to the office. Sick students must wear a mask before entering office area

Library is closed to students. Students order books online and librarian delivers to classrooms

Music classes-teacher wears a mask at all times and maintains at least 6 foot distance whenever possible. Students spread as far apart as possible. In most cases at least 6 feet.

PE-teacher wears a mask at all times. Separate entry and exit doors to gym. 6 feet social distancing whenever possible

ELL-teacher wears a mask at all times, students six feet apart, plexiglass barrier in place

Counselling-one student at a time. 6 feet socially distanced. Teacher wears a mask at all times

SLP- one student at a time. 6 feet socially distanced. Teacher wears a mask at all times

Resource/LA-small groups, teacher wears a mask at all times, 6 feet social distancing

4. Separate supervised waiting area (indoor):

Large foyer outside of office is designated as waiting area 45 feet by 35 feet

5. Separate supervised waiting area (outdoor):

Covered area at front of school just outside the office so secretaries can see student through the windows

6.Method for cleaning and disinfection of sports equipment and manipulatives:

PE and music classes are clustered by cohorts so that items only need to be cleaned after every second class. When possible each cohort uses different equipment so cleaning only needs to happen at end of the day. Classes are outside whenever possible. Strenuous activities limited to outside only. Students sanitize hands before and after each class.
